Here are just some of the many ways we are reducing our waste:-

- Water conservation

- Reducing our carbon footprint
- Waste minimisation and recycling
- Use of vegetable based inks
- Sourcing environmentally responsible paper for our manufacturing process ensuring Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) chain of custody
- Ensuring that CO₂ emissions are considered in the purchase of company vehicles.

It takes around 17 trees per ton to manufacture paper. We therefore attempt to minimize the environmental impact of our products by sourcing raw materials responsibly, implementing efficiencies in production and managing our raw materials and measuring our waste. This provides the facility to ensure we are reducing our environmental impact.

Accreditations

Using FSC paper sourced only from managed forests approved by the Forest Stewardship Council guarantees that trees used are grown and felled responsibly.
